

Signature Application for **Emails**

- 1. Login to your Gmail Account
- Click on the Gear Icon () at the top right of the screen.
- 3. Select **Settings** from the drop-down box.
- 4. Scroll down until you see the Signature section (pictured below)





Adding Components of the Signature:

- 1. Type your name (bold text), add 2 spaces, add "|", add 2 spaces, type your title (un-bold text)
- 2. Hit Enter twice
- 3. Import the CI Logo using the image icon highlighted above in red
- 4. In the pop up window, go to Web Address (URL).
- Copy and Paste this URL inside the box provided: http://wwwassets.e-ci.com/Images/Email/CI-Logo.png, hit Select
- 6. Once the image has been imported, highlight the image and select the link icon, highlighted above in green
- 7. In the small pop up screen, select *Change*, another pop up window will appear, copy and paste this link: http://www.e-ci.com, hit **OK**
- 8. Hit Enter twice
- 9. Type in your information as seen in the example above. Note: Don't forget to link your email and the website using the link icon in green, and the previous step
- 10. Once finished, scroll down to the bottom of the Settings screen and select, Save Changes

You have successfully created your new signature!



Signature Application for iPhones

Only proceed with these steps after you have created your signature explained previously.


- 1. Login to your **Gmail Account**
- 2. Hit *Compose* on the top left of the screen.
- 3. Create a "dummy" email and send it to yourself
- Once you see the "dummy" email in your Inbox, go to your iPhone

Importing Signature to iPhone

- Open your Email Client, and open the "dummy" email
- 2. Select all the components in your signature (see image to the right), select **Copy**
- 3. Return to the Home Screen and open **Settings**
- 4. Scroll down the Settings section and select *Mail*, *Contacts*, *Calendars*
- 5. Scroll down the Mail, Contacts, Calendars section and select **Signature**
- 6. In the Signature window, press and hold until the Copy/Paste pop up appears (see image to the right)
- 7. Hit Paste
- 8. You should see your complete email signature inside the window
- Do a test email from your phone and view the email from your desktop to make sure everything looks correct.

(Note: the signatures may look different on your phone as the phone adjusts the graphics for screen size)
